Description of Work:

The design and construction of this site provided single lane ramp' and dock (17 trailer spaces, 4 single vehicle spaces plus 1 ADA trailer and 1 ADA single vehicle. It includes gravel parking areas and concrete ADA parking, lighting, efficient traffic flow, with the ultimate goal of providing recreational users as well as anglers high quality fishing and boating opportunities. The WRC assumes all costs associated with maintenance and operations of this facility.

Project Status/Work Accomplished:

Wildlife Commission staff constructed a concrete boat ramp, an 8-foot x 56-foot floating dock and a gravel parking lot with space for four cars and 17 vehicles with trailers. (18 trailer and 5 single vehicle spaces including the ADA). The entire area is ADA accessible with a dedicated single-vehicle parking space, a dedicated space for a vehicle with trailer, paved sidewalks and assist rails on the dock. Gravel Parking lot was constructed and ADA sidewalks were completed. The Dawson's Creek BAA was opened back up to the public on April 10.
