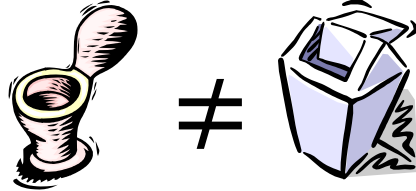
## Water Conservation Tips for Everyone



Turn off faucets. Use lavatory sinks and wash bins efficiently.

Don't use toilets as trashcans.

Toilets use 2-7 gallons per *flush*.



Check, report and repair leaks immediately.  
In this facility, report leaks to \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_.

A faucet that drips 3 times per second wastes **26 gallons** of water per day!

If a leak is not fixed immediately, catch leaking water and use it to water plants.



Run only full loads in dishwashers and washing machines.

Automatic dishwashers use 9-12 gallons per *load*.

When you must use hoses for cleaning or landscaping, use high-pressure nozzles.
