RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND ENDORSING THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN OF 2019 FOR BRUNSWICK COUNTY

Intent/Purpose

Safe and effective management of municipal solid waste is a priority of the Town. Collection and disposal of municipal solid waste for town residents and many businesses is handled by Brunswick County. In addition, Town Council has implemented recycling programs to reduce the volume of waste generated in the community and has taken steps to buy recycled supplies where possible.

NC General Statute 130A-309.09A(b) requires each unit of local government, either individually or in cooperation with other units of local government, to update the Ten Year Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan at least every three years. Since Brunswick County manages solid waste in Leland, the Town is included in the County's plan.

Staff has provided the County with additional updated data on the Town's program. This resolution accepts and endorses the County's three-year update to the solid waste management plan.

RESOLVED:

That the Town Council accepts and endorses Brunswick County's 2019 Ten Year Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, as updated.
