A Draft Renewal Permit has been prepared for Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. to store hazardous waste at the facility under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). North Carolina has been authorized by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to administer RCRA including the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) of 1984. The State has determined that Safety-Kleen's proposed activities as identified in the application satisfies the full intent of the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules and Solid Waste Management Act as amended. When finalized this draft permit issued by the State of North Carolina will constitute a complete permit under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. will continue management of hazardous waste in three container storage areas, one 15,000-gallon tank and two Drum Washer/Dumpster Units as regulated by the renewal permit. Hazardous wastes are brought on site from off-site customers and also generated as a result of managing the hazardous waste. The wastes are spent mineral spirits, spent immersion cleaner, paint wastes, and dry-cleaning wastes.

The North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules require that the public be given a forty-five (45) day period to comment on the draft permit. This forty-five (45) day period will commence on September 8, 2013. The draft permit is available for review during office hours (9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) Monday through Friday. All data submitted by the applicant is available as part of the administrative record. Persons wishing to comment on either this permit or the proposed permit conditions or to object to the permit issuance should submit such comments in writing prior to October 23, 2013. All comments received within the forty-five (45) day period will be considered before the final permit decision is made. Comments should be sent to:

A public hearing to receive comments concerning the issuance of the proposed permit will be held on October 10, 2013 at 10:00 a.m., Town Hall Complex, Building B, Councilor's Chambers at 900 Seventh Avenue, Garner, North Carolina. Attendees may submit a written statement for the official record in addition to their oral statement or they may submit written comments in lieu of making an oral presentation. When a final permit decision is made to either issue, deny, or modify the permit, notice will be given to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final decision.
