

MEETING NOTICE

The next meeting of the North Carolina Mountain Resources Commission will be held on October 19, 2012. The meeting will be held in the clubhouse at Lake Tahoma located at 3026 Lake Tahoma Road in Marion, NC. The meeting will begin at 1:00 PM and conclude by 3:00 PM. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct the business of the Commission.

Directions from Asheville:

I-40 east to exit 72 (Old Fort exit)

Proceed through Old Fort (now on old highway 70) another 6 miles past Old Fort) to the intersection of highway 70 and Lake Tahoma Rd, (highway 80). There is a light at this intersection. Turn left (north) and proceed approximately 3 miles to the black iron gate on the right. At approximately 2.5 miles, you will see the dam on the right. The gate is approximately ½ mile past the dam. Park on the road as close to the gate as you can. Walk through the gate onto the bridge to the Casino. We will meet in the round portion on the right of the Casino. The Casino is a green structure about 75 yards from shore. We may have someone to assist with parking.

Coming from the east traveling west on I-40 take exit 86.

Turn right (north) onto 221/226 and proceed approximately 5 miles to the intersection of 221/226 and old highway 70. There is a traffic signal at this intersection. Turn left (west) and proceed almost 2 miles to Lake Tahoma Rd. (highway 80). (traffic signal). Turn right (north) and go approximately 3 miles to the black iron gate which is approximately ½ mile past the dam. Park as close to the gate as possible

From the north

Come down 221/226 to the intersection of 221/226 and old highway 70. (Traffic signal at intersection). Turn right (west) and proceed about 2 miles to the intersection of old highway 70 and Lake Tahoma Rd. (highway 80). Turn right (north) and proceed about 3 miles to the black iron gate. Park at the gate as close as possible.
