Dear Resident:

In March, 2013, a contractor hired by the North Carolina Division of Waste Management (Division) sampled the soil gas near your apartment. This testing was performed for confirmatory purposes. Previous soil gas sampling had identified contaminants above the screening value we use to evaluate the potential for vapors to impact indoor air.

The Division is requesting your permission to collect an indoor air sample from your apartment to determine if the contaminants in the soil gas are migrating indoors. The Division's contractor will work with you to determine the best date/time to conduct the sampling. The sampler is not much larger than a tube of lipstick and would need to be in an open area for 7 days. Lab analysis generally takes at least 2 weeks. After the results have been reviewed, I will send you a copy of the results and what actions are recommended.

There will be no cost to you for the sampling or the lab analysis. If you agree to have your indoor air sampled complete the attached consent for sampling and return using the self-addressed stamped envelope included.
