RECREATIONAL FISHING TOURNAMENT LICENSE TO SELL FISH

Requirements

- What:** Recreational fishing tournaments that want to sell fish caught from a tournament are required to purchase a *Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish*.
- When:** Application for a *Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish* must be filed with a NCDMF license office 30 days prior to the start of the tournament by the Tournament Organizer.
- Where:** The *Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish* can be purchased from any NCDMF license office.

- Why:** The purpose of this law is to improve the quality of data used in the management of the State's fishery resources.
- Who:** All recreational fishing tournaments in North Carolina that sell their catch.
- Cost:** The cost of the *Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish* is \$100.00
- Facts:** The recreational tournament can only sell fish through a licensed fish dealer (the Tournament Organizer may wish to purchase a *Fish Dealer License* to meet this requirement).

Fish plates, including free fish plates to tournament participants, from fish caught during the tournament requires the tournament organizer to purchase this license.

The fish dealer must complete a NCDMF trip ticket.

The Tournament Organizer must file a license application for this license 30 days in advance of the tournament. Organizers not filing an application 30 days in advance will not receive a license and the recreational tournament cannot sell fish.

Proceeds from the sale of fish must be used for religious, educational, civic, or conservation purposes. Proceeds are not to be used to pay for tournament expenses.

The Tournament Organizer must file a *Recreational Fishing Tournament Disposition of Proceeds from the Sale of Fish* Form within 30 days after the last day of the tournament to the NCDMF.

Information on this form includes type and amount of fish sold and a contact person whose organization is benefiting from the sale of fish.

Application Process:

The Tournament Organizer can apply for the *Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish* in person by coming into one of the NCDMF license offices.

The Tournament Organizer can apply through the mail to the Morehead City License office only. If applying through the mail, the applicant must complete an *Application for the Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish*.

- Follow all instructions for the application, including required attached documentation.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. – Do all fishing tournaments need the Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish License?

A. – No, only tournaments that plan to sell fish must have this license. Organizers of tournaments must apply 30 days before the tournament to get this license.

Q. – Do tournaments need to report the proceeds from the sale of fish?

A. – Yes, tournaments must report the proceeds from the sale of fish. The sale of fish must go through a licensed Fish Dealer. The proceeds from the sale of fish may be used only for charitable, religious, educational, civic, or conservation purposes and is not to be used to pay tournament expenses.

Q. – Can vessels fishing in tournaments with a Commercial Fishing Vessel Registration and an individual with a Standard or Retired Commercial Fishing License sell their catch instead of giving it to the tournament?

A. – No, vessels and fishermen participating in tournaments with a Recreational Fishing Tournament to Sell Fish License are not to engage in commercial fishing activities.

Q. – Does a tournament need a Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish if the tournament is selling fish plates from fish caught in the tournament?

A. – Yes, the sale of fish plates, including free fish plates to participants, from fish caught during the tournament requires the tournament organizer to purchase a license. Additionally, the tournament must sell the fish through a Fish Dealer (the tournament organizer may wish to purchase a Fish Dealer License to meet this requirement).



INSTRUCTIONS

RECREATIONAL FISHING TOURNAMENT LICENSE TO SELL FISH APPLICATION

(Applications must be received by the Division of Marine Fisheries
30 days prior to the tournament date)

Applications are to be completed and signed by the Tournament Organizer. Businesses that are the tournament organizer requesting a license must have the Responsible Party (business agent) complete and sign the application. The Responsible Party (business agent) is the person who coordinates, supervises or otherwise directs operations of a business entity, such as a corporate officer or executive-level supervisor of business operations and is the person responsible for use of the issued license in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. Individuals applying for a license for another under the authority of Power of Attorney must submit a **PHOTOCOPY** of the Power of Attorney and current picture identification.

- A. Provide a **PHOTOCOPY** of one of the following current picture identifications:
1. Driver's License; or
 2. State Identification (issued by DMV); or
 3. Military Identification; or
 4. Passport; or
 5. Resident Alien Card (green card)
- B. If you are applying as a business, you must provide:
1. If incorporated, **PHOTOCOPY** of Articles of Incorporation and list of current corporate holders.
 2. If written agreement partnership, **PHOTOCOPY** of written partnership agreement.
 3. If not incorporated or written partnership, **PHOTOCOPY** current Assumed Name Statements, if filed, and **PHOTOCOPY** of business privilege tax certificates, if applicable.
- C. A **Recreational Tournament License To Sell Fish** license application must have the following:
1. Check one:
 - a. New application (i.e., new license)
 - b. Updating current license
 - c. Replacing a current license
 2. **Recreational Tournament License To Sell Fish** numbers, if renewing the license. This number is located on the license to the right of the words *Recreational Fishing Tournament License to Sell Fish*.
 3. Complete all the applicable Participant Information (tournament organizer), including the Participant Identification number. This number is listed to the right of the word *Participant #* on your license
 4. Tournament name (must have a tournament name) and tournament dates.
 5. Tournament location (physical address of weigh-in).
 6. List those that may receive charitable proceeds from the sale of fish from the tournament (actual recipients will be recorded after the tournament is finished on the Recreational Fishing Tournament Disposition of Proceeds from the Sale of Fish form).
 7. Sign the Application.

8. Certification Statement Form for Licenses completed, signed and notarized.

- D. Fees:
1. \$125.00
 2. \$12.50 replacement fee for replacing or updating current/valid license.
- E. Method of payment: Personal check, money order or Cashier check. Make payable to *North Carolina Division of Marine Fisheries*. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks.

- **This license is only valid for the dates of the tournament up to 7 days.**

RECREATIONAL FISHING TOURNAMENT DISPOSITION
OF PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF FISH

- A. The Tournament Organizer must submit the Recreational Fishing Tournament Disposition of Proceeds from the Sale of Fish Form to the North Carolina Division of Marine Fisheries License Office in Morehead City within 30 days of the last date of the tournament.
- B. The Tournament Organizer is to record the charitable receipts from the sale of the fish. Proceeds from the sale of fish must be used for religious, educational, civic, or conservation purposes. Proceeds are not to be used to pay for tournament expenses.
- C. The Tournament Organizer is to record the pounds of fish sold by species.
- D. The Tournament Organizer is to record the Fish Dealer Name and NCDMF Dealer Number (D-Number).
- E. The Tournament Organizer is to attach a **PHOTOCOPY** of the NCDMF Trip Ticket completed by the Fish Dealer at time of sale.

I understand that as a condition of accepting a permit from the Division of Marine Fisheries, I agree to abide by all conditions of the permit and agree, that if specific conditions of the permit as identified for the permit are violated, or if false information was provided in the application for initial issuance, renewal or transfer, the permit may be suspended or revoked by the Fisheries Director.

5. NC General Statute §113-221 requires the NC Division of Marine Fisheries to provide a current copy of the rules governing activities authorized by the license you are purchasing. You have the right to request a current rulebook in hardbound or electronic format.

6. For for-hire fishing licenses and endorsements, I affirm that I have liability insurance and that I am knowledgeable of USCG safety requirements for the vessel(s) used in the operation in accordance with G.S. 113-168.6.

7. If application is for a Standard/Retired Commercial Fishing License with a Shellfish Endorsement or a Shellfish License for NC Residents I affirm that I have received the required harvester training.
